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Visit of Delegates from Uster Technologies AG, Switzerland to the Cotton Association of India (CAI)

Mr. Oswald Baldischwieler, Vice President, Product Solutions, Production Head at Uster Technologies AG, accompanied by his colleague Mr. Jagdish C. Kulkarni, visited the Cotton Association of India (CAI) on Monday, 4th August 2025 for a focused technical dialogue on the future developments in testing of Indian cottons, with particular attention to trash content and contamination control.

Key Highlights:

An in-depth technical discussion was held with Dr. Pradeep Mandhyan, CEO - Research and Cotton Testing, CAI. The conversation centered around current testing methodologies and explored future developments to enhance testing precision, consistency, and efficiency in Indian cotton evaluation.

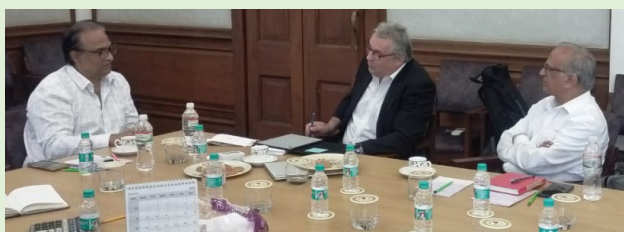


The Uster delegation visited CAI's Cotton Testing Laboratory and the Standard Grade Box Department to gain a comprehensive understanding of the existing Indian cotton testing infrastructure and protocols.

Mr. Oswald shared global best practices in cotton testing and quality assessment, providing practical suggestions for innovation in testing procedures and strategies to minimize contamination.

Meeting Outcome:

The interaction was highly productive and insightful. Both parties exchanged meaningful technical perspectives, laying the foundation for future collaboration between Uster and CAI. The visit marked an important step toward supporting innovation and modernization in the testing of Indian cottons to meet evolving global quality standards.



India, China, Brazil and Bangladesh are Projected Leaders for the 2025/26 season – ICAC

Cotton production, consumption, and trade projections for the 2025/26 season are largely unchanged from last month, with production slightly outpacing consumption (25.9 to 25.6 million tonnes) and trade holding at 9.7 million tonnes.

Below are the projected leaders in the major categories for the 2025/26 season:

- India will continue to have the most area under cotton – 38% of the world total,
- China will again be the world's top producer, accounting for 24% of global production,
- China is also projected to remain the world's top consumer at 8.2 million tonnes (32% of the global total),
- Bangladesh will remain atop the importers category with 19% of the projected world total, and
- Brazil will remain the top exporter, with 32% of the total shipments.

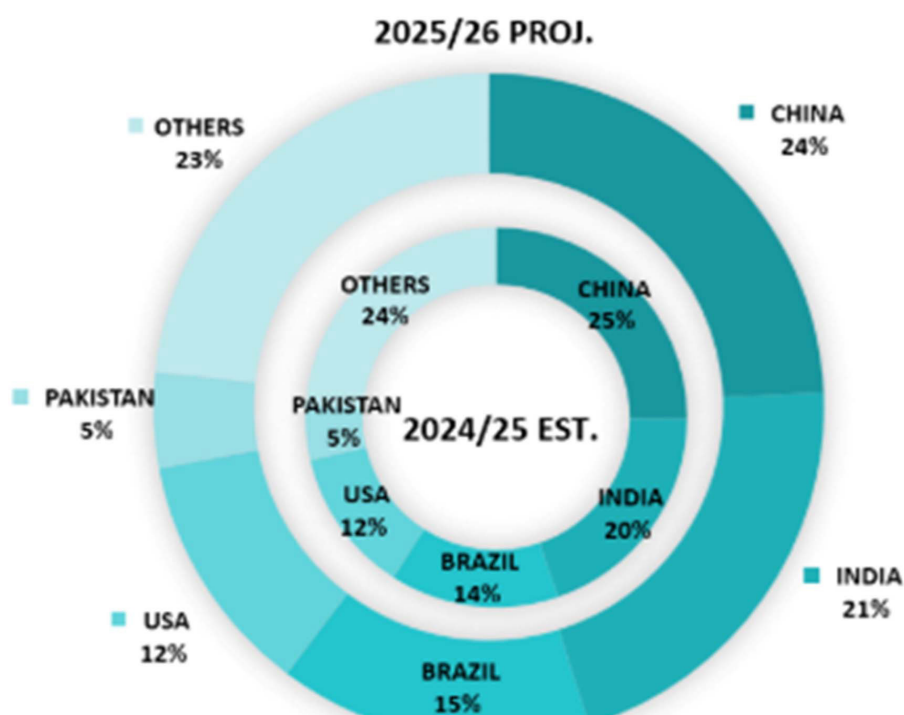
This month's CTM continues to address the data rectification process the ICAC has been undergoing. The initial work of adjusting data for all of our reported regions and countries has begun with updates on India, South Africa, Argentina, and Australia.

The Secretariat's current price forecast for the 2025/26 season, based on current supply and demand estimates, ranges from 57 to 94 cents per pound, with a midpoint of 73 cents per pound. ICAC's price projections are made by Ms Lorena Ruiz, ICAC Economist.

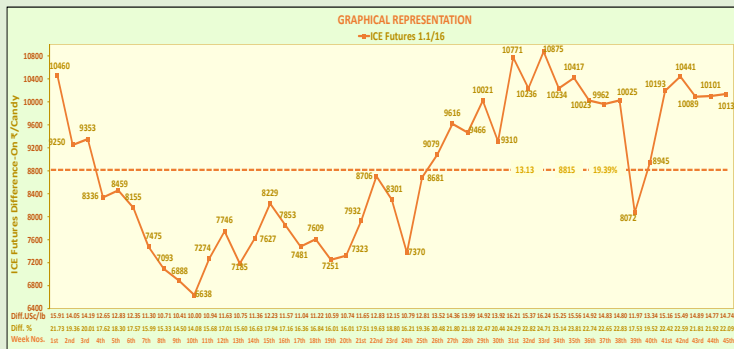
